REMAINING PENDING ACCOUNTS

The following companies have been solicited and we believe should continue to be followed up by leadership and staff.

<u>All State Electric</u> – Tony Boevers attended the Boldt breakfast in late November. We are asking them to consider a \$2,500 annual investment. I have been unable to reach Tony directly by telephone. Jerry Ennis may be helpful in following up with Tony.

<u>Bass Pro Shops</u> – Chip met with Jill Deveroux at their downtown store in 2005. Jill forwarded our materials to their company executives at headquarters. Chip has spoken with Martin MacDonald and Larry Whitely at their headquarters in Kansas (417) 873-5023. They are interested in becoming an investor and should finalize their decision in April. We asked them to consider \$2,500 annually.

<u>Charles S. Givens Interests</u> – They were a \$20,000 investor in Forward II and asked us to mail him the Forward III materials which we did in January. I have been unable to reach Charles by phone – he travels frequently. There is a good chance he will renew. Staff or leadership should follow up.

<u>Clearwater Enterprises</u> – Philippe made this visit and asked Tony Say to consider a \$25,000 five year pledge. We have been unable to connect with Tony by phone.

FRIDAY – Nichols Hills Publishing – They were a \$2,500 Forward II investor. We asked them to consider a \$10,000 five-year pledge. Staff should follow up with Leland.

<u>Gable & Gotwals</u> – Law firm – Philippe made this call on Eric King. Staff or leadership should follow up.

<u>Genzyme</u> - Philippe made this solicitation call and believes the \$25,000 request may be a bit too high.

<u>Globe Life & Accident</u> – Chip has several phone messaged into Ann Allen with no reply. If someone knows her they might have some success in following up. Otherwise, Globe should be put on the decline investment list.

<u>Indian Exploration</u> – Philippe made this solicitation call and asked them to consider \$25,000. Perhaps Larry Nichols, Tom Price or Aubrey could follow up.

<u>Johnson Controls</u> – Chip spoke with Matt Kwiatkowski in March and our request is still in process. If someone knows Matt they might give him one more try. Probably not a high priority pending account.

<u>Mustang Fuel Corporation</u> – Chip called on Carey Joullian in August of 2005. Carey was not overly excited about the Forward III program. He probably would come aboard, perhaps at his Forward II level of \$100,000, if asked to by Larry Nichols.

<u>Oklahoma State University – OKC</u> – Chip had a good meeting with Jerry Carroll in March. I asked them to consider a \$25,000 five-year pledge. They will make their decision in May/June when they do their budgets.

<u>Rees Associates</u> – Chip has had several conversations with Leroy James in March after Bill Cameron encouraged Leroy to make a commitment. Leroy gave me a verbal commitment that they would come aboard, but have not received his pledge form. Staff or Bill Cameron follow up should do the trick.

<u>Remington Park</u> – Chip had a good meeting with Scott Wells in January. They definitely want to become more engaged with the Chamber. I proposed a \$50,000 five-year pledge. Staff follow up with Scott should bring them aboard.

<u>SPARKS</u> – Philippe made this solicitation call. Omar Khoury is the contact person for this small engineering firm. Request is \$1,000 annually.

<u>The Burgess Company</u> - Phil Burgess attended the Boldt breakfast in November and gave Chip a verbal commitment that they would support Forward III. Staff follow up to encourage Phil to send in his pledge form should do it. Jerry Ennis could also help.

<u>United Mechanical</u> – Chip spoke with Rod Rutherford in late March and they were still discussing their involvement. Staff follow up with Rod should do it.

<u>UPS</u> – Philippe made this call on Terry Gilchrist. UPS is generally not a good funding source for economic development programs.
