This Ohio County of 40,000 has combined their Chamber, CIC, CVB and Downtown Development Association under the Partnership Umbrella. RDG is completing an Assessment to launch a funding initiative to fund key programs of the Partnership







This is RDG's fifth engagement with MACOC. After surpassing the \$25 million, all private target goal in December, 2007, this campaign was extended. Revenues will fund economic development and public policy initiatives including advancement of key legislative agenda items focused on transportation. water and education.

This is a \$60 million, 5 year campaign to fund community economic development initiatives involving 15 organizations. RDG's specific responsibility is to generate \$12 million for Chamber implemented economic development activities







Spawned by Chamber leadership, the CFP is designed to harness and focus resources from the 7 county area on major product issues impacting growth. Launched in January, 2008, initial projects include regional transportation and leadership development. RDG is managing a \$10 million funding initiative and also provided extensive counsel on organizational transformation.

Our third engagement with the Board of Trade, RDG is completing an assessment of regional support for the GWI agenda. In this case, RDG has recommended not moving forward with a funding campaign due to numerous internal challenges that must be addressed to improve the climate for a successful funding endeavor.









RDG is completing a \$2.5 million campaign to supplement public funding for this regional economic development program. This is our second engagement with the Topeka Chamber.

RDG is completing an investment campaign for this Florida County of 125,000. Dollars generated are supplementing Chamber dues dollars and will support public policy and economic development activities.







Our second engagement, RDG is managing a \$6 million funding effort, with matching public funds, to support economic development, workforce and public policy initiatives of the Chamber

After completing a reorganization that brought the Chamber of Commerce, Economic Development Alliance, and a consortium of community foundations under the Partnership umbrella, RDG was retained to develop a new unified funding model and manage the subsequent investment campaign. The assessment was completed earlier this year and RDG is currently in the early stages of a \$10 million campaign.
